LABOUR ANALGESIA - ALL YOU NEED TO KNOW

1.) What is labour analgesia? Why should a pregnant woman during delivery get it done?

Labour pain is one of the worst pain a woman can experience. Uterine contractions are so severe that the women can have physical and psychological trauma because of fear, anxiety, pain causing increase in hormones in body which may cause harm to mother and fetus. The ideal labor analgesia technique should be safe for both mother and infant, should not interfere in progress of labor and delivery, give pain relief and have minimal side effects.

2.) How is it done? Who can ask/ consent for it?

Various pharmacological/non pharmacological techniques are available like, breathingtechniques, hydrotherapy, acupuncture, TENS , gas inhalation (entonox), sedatives , nerveblocks and epidural. These are done by anesthesiologists and obstetricians .According to ASA& ACOG , MATERNAL (MOTHER) REQUEST IS SUFFICIENT medical indication for pain relief during labor.

3.) What is walking epidural?when is it done? what are the advantages?

when the mother is starting to dilate and contractions are continuous and obstetrician and mother consents the anesthesiologist places a small catheter in the spine (epidural space) of the mother and give titrated doses of the local anesthetics so that the mother will be pain free but at the same time be able to move around, hence the name WALKING EPIDU-RAL.. This is nothing short of a MIRACLE. This not only gives pain relief, but also improves uterine blood flow, does not effect the fetal out come and avoid the side effects of pain killers being given. It has to be done only under anaesthesiologists supervision

4)Who Cannot get an epidural done ?Any contraindications?

A) Patient refusal ,any local infection, any conditions where there is increase in cranial pressure , coagulation disorders and in shock.

5.) Labour analgesia, boon or bane?

A) definitely it is a boon to the birthing mother as child birth is like re birth and with painless ,anxious free delivery when done in experienced hands makes the parturiant have memorable and happy normal delivery with the healthy baby crying in the hand and mother having a smile on her happy face.

DANGERS OF NEGLECTING ORAL HEALTH

COVID-19 vaccines saved 20 million lives in 1 year

A recent study published in the journal Lancet Infectious DiseaseTrusted Source estimates that COVID-19 vaccines helped reduce the global death toll by 63% during the first year they became available. The study also found that a more equitable distribution of COVID-19 vaccines could have prevented a significant number of deaths in low-income nations.

Dr. Oliver Watson, a researcher at Imperial College London, said, "Our findings offer the most complete assessment to date of the remarkable global impact that vaccination has had on the COVID-19 pandemic. [...] Our findings show that millions of lives have likely been saved by making vaccines available to people everywhere, regardless of their wealth.

"However, more could have been done. If the targets set out by the WHO had been achieved, we estimate that roughly 1 in 5 of the estimated lives lost due to COVID-19 in low-income countries could have been prevented," he added.

Andhra Medical College gears up for centenary fete

Having started as a medical school, graduating into the Vizagapatam Medical College and then taking the name of Andhra Medical College (AMC), the oldest medical college in Andhra Pradesh is on the threshold of celebrating its centenary year.

struction of a multi-storeyed Centenary Academic Block (CAB), at an estimated cost of 1 25 crore, to mark the centenary year. The CAB will have four lecture halls with a capacity of 300 each, three examination halls with 250 seating capacity each, a library and an auditorium to accommodate 1,000 to 1,500 audience," Dr. P.V. Sudhakar, former principal of the AMC told. He said the government sanctioned ¹ 500 crore to each medical college in the State under the

'Naadu- Nedu' programme for renovation a year ago. "The government agreed to my pleas for sanctioning 1 600 crore to the AMC as it has a number of old buildings that need more funds for repairs and renovation," he said.

HYPERTENSION - A SILENT KILLER

Hypertension (high blood pressure)is commonly occurring serious health prob-lem effecting nearly 300 millions people in our country.It is an easily detectable treatable conditions which usually does not cause any symptoms initially.Like Termite which hollowed wood from inside initially and does not manifest its ill effect till it breaks down wood.Similiarly high blood pressure does not cause any symptom till it hit its target organs causing Heart attacks, Stroke, Blindness, Kidnney failure etc. Hence an extensive, educative proramme among population can prevent untoward effects of uncontrolled Blood pressure significantly. A SYSTOLIC PRESSURE between 100 to 140

m.m. of Hg and a DIASTOLIC PRESSURE between 60 to 90 m.m. of Hg is considered to be normal.

CAUSE —In 90 to 95% of patients cause of high blood pressure is unknown. They are labeled as PRIMARY OR ESSENTIAL HYPERTEN-SION. In about 5 to 10% of patients there is a causative underlying disease like Coarctation of Aorta, Renal Artery stenosis, d uring Pregnancy, certain drugs etc. They are labeled as SECONDARY HY-PERTENSION SYMPTOMS —As stated earlier in majority of cases there are no symptoms and it is detected during routine examination. However some patient may complaint of Headache, Giddiness, Breathlessness, Chest pain, Undue tiredness, bleeding from Nose or blood in Urine, diminished Vision, palpitation etc.

INVESTIGATIONS——Once detected with high blood pressure following basic Investigation should be carried out. CBP,CUE,CRP,FBSL,Hb A1C,LIPID PROFILE, S.ELECTROLYTES, S. CREATININE, ECG, X-RAY CHEST – PAV, FUNDUS EXAMINATION, 2D ECHO with DOPPLER.

TREATMENT -There are two steps.

1.NON-DRUG THERAPY —It consist of A.restricting salt intake to 2 to 3 gms per day, weight reduction, Quitting smoking, avoiding fast n processed food,regular physical exercise,adapting mental relaxation technique like Yoga, meditation etc. After adopting above mentioned measures if blood pressure is not controlled then patient needs Drug Therapy. Following group of Drugs are used to treat high blood pressure.

1. DIURETICS, ACE INHIBITOR, ARB, BETA BLOCKER, CALCIUM CHANNEL BLOCKER, VASO DILATOR etc.

IN NUTSHELL

Important message to carry home

- 1. High blood pressure is commonly occuring serious disease. Around 300 millions people are suffering from it in INDIA.
- 2. Timely detection and treatment can prevent serious fatal complications of this disease.
- 3. Uncontrolled Blood pressure can damage Heart, Brain, Eyes,
- Kidneys, Blood vessels. They are known as target organs.
 4. Treatment for high blood pressure is usually lifelong. Hence never discontinue treatment without consent of your doctor.
- 5. Usually high blood pressure does not cause any symptoms unless there is sudden high rise or damage to target organs. Hence it is called Silent killer.
- 6. Initially blood pressure should be checked up once a week. Once controlled, it can be checked up once in three months..
- 7. Inform your doctor if you experience side effects of drugs like Breathlessness, palpitation, decreased Libido.

8. Weight reduction, salt restriction, restricted use of sweets, ghee, plenty of green vegetables, using sunflower oil ,Olive oil as cooking medium, yoga, meditation etc goes a long way in controlling blood pressure and thereby preventing its complications.

9. Contact your doctor immediately if you notice chest pain, breathlessness, palpitation, undue tiredness, diminished

vision, body swelling, decreased urine output.

In conclusion we can say controlled blood pressure is not a serious disease.lf you obsvere above mentioned precautions, you can lead a normal life with high blood pressure.

Government bans private practice by new doctors

The Telangana government issued orders imposing a ban on the private practice by the government doctors. This would be applicable to the newly-recruited doctors and those who shift from teaching to non-teaching wings. The government issued orders making amendments to the Telangana Medical Education Services Rules bringing in total ban on the private practice by the doctors.

According to sources, the government has taken notice of the absence of the doctors from their duties, leading to the suffering of the patients. A senior official said that though the government doctors should be present in the hospital, in most cases the doctors leave the hospital after a few hours of service. Similarly, the doctors in the primary health centres in rural areas do not bother to visit them at least for three days in a week.

गैरकानूनी तरीके से घुसने वाले मारतीयों की संख्या 25 प्रतिशत बढ़ी

अवैध एंट्री का नया गेटवे कनाडा



अमेरिका के टेक्सास में मैक्सिको से आए ट्रक के अंदर अब तक 51 शव मिल चुके हैं। ये लोग अवैध तरीके से ट्रक में ठूंस-ठूंस कर लाए गए थे। इस भयावह घटना के चलते शरणार्थियों का मुद्दा फिर से गरमा गया है। इसका एक पहलू यह भी है कि हाल के सालों में गैरकानूनी तरीके से घुसने के मामले में भारतीयों की संख्या भी तेजी से बढ़ रही है।

हाल ही में, अमेरिकी संघीय एजेंसी ने भारतीयों की कनाडा सीमा से अवैध एंट्री कराने वाले एक गिरोह का पर्दाफाश किया। गिरोह के सरगना जसपाल गिल को गिरफ्तार कर लिया गया है, जो कैलिफोर्निया से यह नेटवर्क चलाता था। कैब के जरिए अमेरिका पहुंचाया– जांच में शामिल एक संघीय एजेंट ने बताया कि इस गिरोह ने उबर कैब के जरिए हजारों भारतीयों को गैरकानूनी तरीके से अमेरिका पहुंचाया है। गिल ने हर व्यक्ति से 23 लाख से 55 लाख रुपए वसूले। इन लोगों को पर्यटक वीसा पर कनाडा लाया जाता है, यहां से उन्हें नकली दस्तावेज पर उबर कैब के जरिए अमेरिका लाया जाता है।

लोगों के पास होते हैं फर्जी दस्तावेज– होमलैंड सिक्योरिटी एजेंट डेविड ए स्पिट्जर ने बताया- एथिया, विशेष रूप से भारत से बड़ी संख्या में लोगों को उबर के जरिए लाया जा रहा है। अक्सर कानूनी पेचीदिगयों से निपटने के लिए इनके पास फर्जी दस्तावेज होते हैं। गिल गिरोह के 17 उबर अकाउंट मिल चुके हैं। एक अकाउंट से ही उसने 90 यात्राएं की हैं। मौटे तौर पर गिरोह ने 1,530 चक्कर लगाए और हजारों भारतीयों को प्रवेश कराया।

Bhutan sets reopening date and increases daily tourist tax

pandemic began more than two years ago, officials said, as the tiny Himalayan kingdom looks to revive its economy. Wedged between China and India, the country with scenic natural beauty and ancient Buddhist culture, took drastic early steps and banned tourism, a major source of income, in March 2020 when the first COVID-19 case was detected there.

The constitutional monarchy of less than 800,000 people has reported fewer than 60,000 infections and only 21 deaths, but the \$3 billion economy contracted in the last two fiscal years, pushing more people into poverty.

The Tourism Council of Bhutan (TCB) said tourists would be allowed to enter from Septem-

Bhutan will reopen for international tourists from September for the first time since the ber 23. They will, however, be charged a Sustainable Development Fee of \$200 per tourist per night, up from the \$65 charged for three decades. Officials said the new fee would offset tourists' carbon impact.

> "COVID-19 has allowed us to reset — to rethink how the sector can be best structured and operated... while keeping carbon footprints low," Tandi Dorji, TCB chairman and the country's foreign minister, said in a statement.

> Authorities said Bhutan had revised standards for service providers, such as hotels, guides, tour operators, and drivers. Tourism employs 50,000 people and contributed an annual average of about \$84 million in the three years before the pandemic in direct foreign exchange.

Oman's Tourism Recovering Fast



Oman welcomed 32,570 Indian tourist arrivals in May 2022. A total of 13,481 Indian travelers visited Oman in January 2022, compared to 7,340 in January 2021. In the following months, February recorded 15,664 visits (up from 10,333 in February 2021), March 22,938 (up from 18,623 in March 2021), and April 24,881 (a sharp rise from 5,919 in April 2021).

The National Centre for Statistics and Information (NCSI) has released a monthly report on tourist indicators for April 2022 revealing that 577,000 tourists had visited Oman, while 1.2 million left the nation by the end of April 2022. Oman received travellers from GCC nations, India, Yemen, Germany, and United Kingdom by the end of April 2022.

According to the survey, three to five-star hotels generated a revenue of OMR 60 million by the end of April from 511,000 tourists, indicating an 86.3 per cent increase over April 2021. In April 2022, the total occupancy rate in hotels was 31.6 per cent, with 82,000 guests, as compared to 39 per cent in April 2021, a decline of 18.9 per cent. In contrast, 75,000 visitors visited during the same month in 2021, a rise of 9.7 per cent.

In April 2022, there were a total of 245,799 outbound visitors, compared to 81,821 tourists in April 2021. According to the report, Omanis had the highest number of outbound travellers, with 126,200 (compared to 28,071 in 2021), followed by 119,599 foreigners (compared to 53,751 in April 2021). The total number of visitors arriving in Oman in April 2022 was 163,000, an increase of 12 times over the previous year's inbound tourists of 13,000 visitors. There were 74,111 Gulf tourists in April 2022, accounting for 45.5 per cent of all inbound visitors.

Greece Welcomes Back Tourists As COVID-19 Restrictions Ease



Greek government and tourism industry officials say they are confident the number of visiting tourists will continue to rise this year now that pandemic-related restrictions have effectively lifted. Many of the visitors who arrived in Athens in June said they were pleased to be able to travel again after COVID-19 measures had eased. "Remem-

bering how the pandemic was and seeing everything so empty and dead, it's nice to see that everything is picking up again," said a tourist from Colombia as she visited the Acropolis. Another tourist, a woman from Switzerland travelling with her friend from Portugal, said they were happy to be in Greece, only a few months after taking in the sights in the Dominican

But challenges and uncertainty cast shadows over the post-pandemic landscape. And a full global recovery could take as long as the catastrophe itself, according to projections and interviews by The Associated Press in 10 countries this month. Greece's minister for tourism himself recently expressed caution about the impact of external factors on the rising visitor

Helicopter services open for tourists in Ladakh



The helicopter services in Ladakh are now open for tourists to travel across the Union Territory, with the first batch of tourists having already availed the heli-service, officials said.

The first batch took the helicopter ride.

The helicopter services operated by the administration will be available to the locals and tourists in general across sectors in the Union territory, they said.

Rates to avail the service have been notified by the administration for the residents of Ladakh, according to the order from Ladakh's civil aviation department.

'Individuals desirous of booking on the notified routes can book the tickets online at https:/ /heliservice.Ladakh.Gov.In/", the order said.

A distinct booking mechanism has been made available on the portal for passengers other than the residents of Ladakh, they said. The order said that the availability of a ticket will depend upon the number of passengers, weather conditions, or any other operational restrictions.

The administration has opened the services with two choppers — a five-seater B-3 chopper and a larger Mi-172-, they said. The services will cover Leh, Kargil, Padum, Lingshed, Dibling, Neyrak, Diskit, Turtuk, Srinagar, and Jammu to begin with, they said.

Japan starts visa process for restart of tourism as COVID worries wane



Japan resumed visa procedures to accept foreign tourists, taking the first step toward increasing inbound tourism to help turn around its economy as worries about the COVID-19 pandemic wane. The government is initially limiting eligible tourist arrivals to guided tours from 98 countries and regions deemed as having the lowest risk of infection, including the United States, Britain, China, South Korea, Indonesia and Thailand.

Authorities expect full-scale arrival of tourists to start around late June at the earliest as it takes several days at least to complete necessary procedures such as entering applicants' information in a registration system. The easing of entry restrictions follows a step by Japan on June 1 to double its cap on daily arrivals to 20,000 and allow most to forgo COVID-19 tests and quarantine periods. The guided tour participants will be included in the arrival quota.

Since March, Japan has been gradually easing the rules, giving priority to foreign residents, businesspeople, students and returning Japanese citizens among others, while barring the entry of tourists

We will make efforts to restore tourism demand by balancing anti-virus measures, and social and economic activities," transport and tourism minister Tetsuo Saito told a press conference Friday, adding the first group of tourists is expected to arrive next week at the earliest.

Still, it may take some time before Japan reopens its borders to individual tourists as the government remains wary of a potential resurgence of infections, particularly as the country prepares for a House of Councillors election expected next month.
