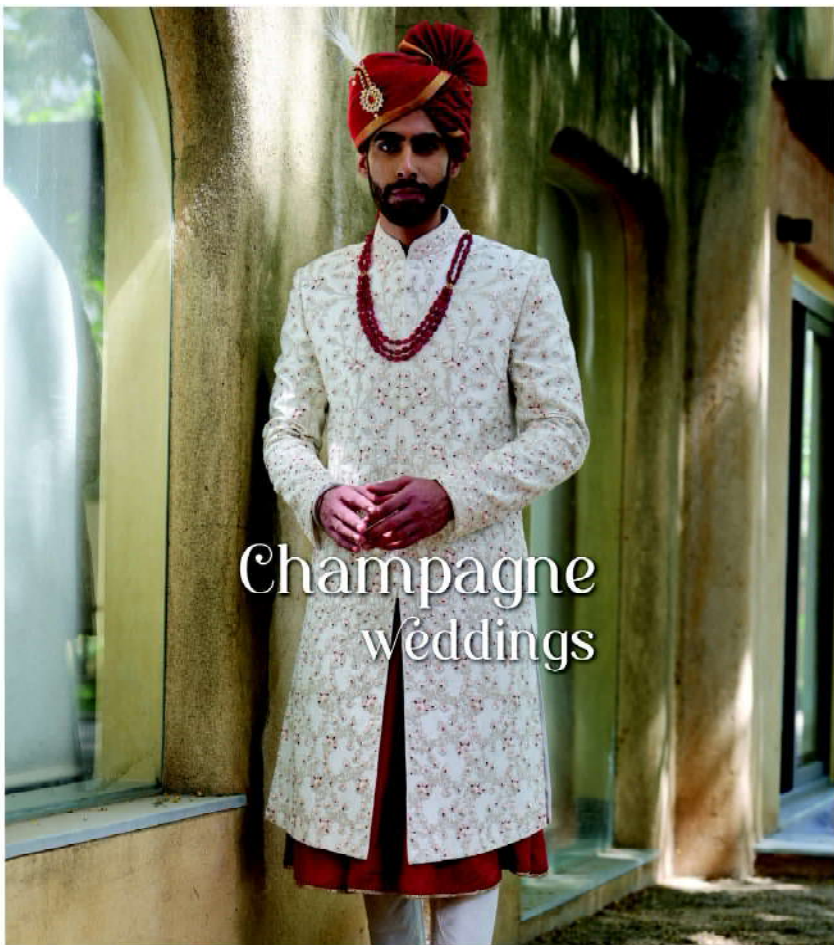
Hyderabad's "third eye"



The Police Command Control Centre will serve as Hyderabad's "third eye" and give the police access to the majority of locations throughout the state thanks to the approximately 9.25 lakh cameras that are connected to it.

The CCC, which is situated on Banjara Hills Road No. 12, is a four-tower complex with 20 floors each that has a built-up area of 5.5 lakh square feet. The double glass curtain wall technology in the towers boosts energy efficiency, thermal comfort, and acoustics.

The building has a two storey parking lot with a helipad on its roof. Tower A, which stands on the left side of the centre, will house the Hyderabad police commissioner's office as well as administrative divisions. The state-level surveillance, which has access to every camera in Telangana, will be in Tower B on the right. The She Teams, emergency response-related agencies, Hawk Eye assistance, and the traffic command centre will also be housed in the tower.

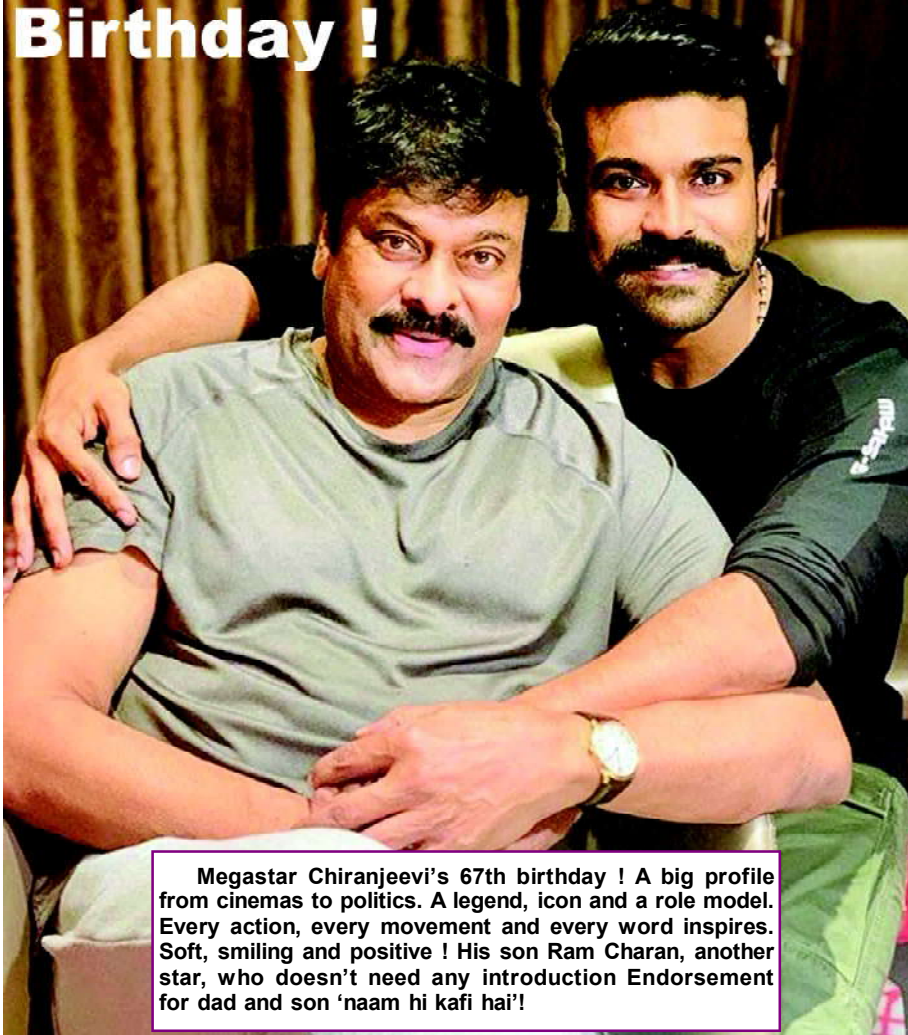

Amitabh Ranjan new Tripura DGP

Senior IPS officer Amitabh Ranjan has been appointed the new Director General of Police of Tripura, an official said. Ranjan, a 1988 batch IPS officer is currently the Special Director of Intelligence Bureau (IB), Delhi. He will replace VS Yadav, who had been given extension till November 2022. Yadav retired in March 2021. Consequent upon repatriation from central deputation and in the interest of public service, the Governor is pleased to appoint Amitabh Ranjan as the DGP and head of police force with effect from the date he assumes charge , a senior official said.



Gaurav Yadav assumes charge as officiating Punjab DGP

Senior IPS officer Gaurav Yadav assumed charge as the officiating Director General of Police of Punjab and reiterated the state government's commitment to eliminate gangster culture and control the drug menace. Yadav was appointed as the officiating DGP after current state police head V K Bhawra proceeded on a two-month leave from Tuesday. After assuming the charge, the officer said the state government and Chief Minister Bhagwant Mann's priority is to eliminate gangster culture and control the drug scourge. "We are committed to giving a secure law and order environment and friendly policing to the state," Yadav said, while also seeking public cooperation in this regard. While speaking in the state assembly recently, Mann announced bringing comprehensive law and order reforms as he reiterated his will to eliminate gangster culture from the state. Mann had said that the state government was duty-bound to curb gangster activities in the state.



Nitin Gupta appointed new CBDT chairman

IRS officer Nitin Gupta has been appointed as the new CBDT chairman, a recent government order said. Gupta, an Indian Revenue Service (IRS) officer of the 1986 batch of the Income Tax cadre, is serving as the Member (investigation) in the Board and is scheduled to retire in September next year. The order issued on June 25 said the "Appointments Committee of the Cabinet has approved the appointment of Shri Nitin Gupta, IRS (IT:86), Member Central Board of Direct Taxes (CBDT) as chairman, Central Board of Direct Taxes from the date of assumption of the post." The post of the CBDT chief was being held in an additional capacity by Board member and 1986-batch IRS officer Sangeeta Singh after J B Mohapatra retired on April 30. The CBDT is headed by a Chairman and can have six members who are in the rank of special secretary. It is the administrative body for the Income Tax department.



Alok Choudhary takes charge as SBI's Managing Director

The country's largest lender State Bank of India said Alok Kumar Choudhary took the charge of Managing Director for its retail business and operations. Earlier, Choudhary was Deputy Managing Director (DMD) for finance at the bank, a release said. He has worked as DMD (HR) and Corporate Development Officer and also served as the Chief General Manager (CGM) of the bank's Delhi circle for three years. The public sector lender is headed by its chairman Dinesh Khara who is assisted by four managing directors. Besides Choudhary, the other managing directors are: C S Setty, Swaminathan J and Ashwini Kumar Tewari.

Reallocation of AP CMO subjects creates ripples in bureaucracy

In a significant development, the State government reallocated key subjects, that were being handled by Advisors to the Chief Minister, to three IAS officers in the Chief Minister’s Office (CMO). The move leaves Ajeya Kallam, Principal Advisor to the CM, and Dr PV Ramesh, Additional Chief Secretary to the CM, without specific subjects.

While Dr PV Ramesh earlier dealt with Education and Medical and Health, Ajeya Kallam looked after Finance, Revenue and many more departments. Another advisor J Murali was earlier allocated animal husbandry, dairy, fisheries, cooperation, marketing and culture. Dr PV Ramesh is also helping in COVID-19 management.


As per the Government Order, the various subjects have been reallocated to Praveen Prakash, Principal Secretary to CM, Solomon Arokia Raj, Secretary to the CM, and K Dhananjaya Reddy, Additional Secretary to the CM. The order sent ripples across the bureaucracy with speculation that the senior advisors might have fallen out of favour. However, a senior source in the CMO told TNIE that Ajeya Kallam and PV Ramesh continue to enjoy the confidence of the CM and the move was more technical than anything else. Kallam commands the respect of the bureaucracy, given his wide experience and spotless career.

Sources said the Chief Minister had appointed the retired bureaucrats as advisors to utilise their experience and expertise in the initial days of his government. With Jagan now getting a grip of the administration, it appears that he may want to utilise their services elsewhere. Sources said one of them was offered the Chief Information Commissioner’s post, but he was reluctant and the same then went to retired bureaucrat Ramesh Kumar.

बढ़ती आस्था-अमेरिका में तेजी से बढ़ रहे मंदिर, 2006 में 53 थे, अब 750 हो गए



अमेरिका में भारतवाशियों की बढ़ती आबादी के साथ वहां मंदिरों की संख्या में भी तेजी से इजाफा हुआ है। लॉस एंजिल्स से न्यूयॉर्क तक घंटियों की गूंज और भजन चिर-परिचित स्वर बनते जा रहे हैं। भारत के हर भाषाई और क्षेत्रीय हिंदू समूह का प्रतिनिधित्व करने वाले मंदिर पूरे अमेरिका में मौजूदगी दर्ज करा रहे हैं।

कॉफी टेबल बुक 'अमेरिका में भारत रेखा' के मुताबिक, 2006 में 53 मंदिर थे। वर्ष 2017 में संख्या बढ़कर 250 हो गई। 2022 में मंदिर बढ़कर 750 हो गए। सबसे ज्यादा संख्या इन्हीं 5 सालों में बढ़ी। इस दौरान 200 प्रतिशत मंदिर बढ़े।

भारत से लोगों का भावनात्मक संबंध- अमेरिका में भारतीय लोग भारत से अपने भावनात्मक संबंधों को महसूस करते हैं। मंदिरों की बढ़ती संख्या संकेत देती है कि 10 लाख से अधिक भारतीयों ने अमेरिका को अपना घर बना लिया है। स्वामी विवेकानंद ने शिकागो में विश्व प्रसिद्ध भाषण देने के बाद 1980 में न्यूयॉर्क और सैन फ्रांसिस्को में वेदांत सोसायटी की स्थापना की थी। वेदांत सोसायटी ने ही अमेरिका का पहला मंदिर सैन फ्रांसिस्को में 1905 में बनवाया।

भारत प्रेम जीवित रखने का एक तरीका यह भी- अमेरिका का ऐसा कोई राज्य नहीं है, जहां आधा दर्जन मंदिर न हों। बढ़ते मंदिर हिंदुओं को उनके देश और संस्कृति से जोड़ रहे हैं। इंजीनियर कटी लक्ष्मी कहती हैं, यहां आकर लोग अधिक धार्मिक हो जाते हैं। यह भारत से हमारा लगाव जीवित रखने का तरीका है।

हिटलर की घड़ी 9 करोड़ में बिकी, जर्मन चांसलर बनने पर मिला था गिफ्ट



एक घड़ी जिसके बारे में कहा जा रहा है कि वो एडोल्फ हिटलर की थी, उसे नीलाम किया गया। इस घड़ी को एलेक्जेंडर हिस्टोरिकल ऑक्शन में करीब 1.1 मिलियन डॉलर यानी 8 करोड़ 72 लाख में बेचा गया। बताया जा रहा है कि इस घड़ी के बिकने के पहले ही 2 से 4 मिलियन डॉलर तक में नीलाम होने का अनुमान है। वॉच प्रो के अनुसार, एडोल्फ हिटलर की एंड्रियास ह्यूबर नाम की ये सोने की घड़ी 20 अप्रैल 1933 को उनके 44 वें जन्मदिन पर मिली थी।

यहूदी नेताओं ने मैरीलैंड के अलेक्जेंडर हिस्टोरिकल ऑक्शन में हुए इस नीलामी की निंदा की थी। हालांकि, ये घड़ी किसे बेची गई है इसके बारे में खुलासा नहीं किया गया है।

1933 में गिफ्ट में मिली थी स्वास्तिक निशान वाली ये घड़ी- द डेलीमेल के अनुसार, इस घड़ी पर स्वास्तिक बना है और उसके साथ तारीख लिखी है। वो तारीख हिटलर का जन्मदिन, जिस दिन वो जर्मनी के चांसलर बने थे। 1933 में जिस दिन नाजी पार्टी ने चुनाव जीता था। माना जाता है कि हिटलर को पार्टी की तरफ से उसी दिन जर्मनी के चांसलर के रूप में चुने जाने पर घड़ी गिफ्ट की थी।

फ्रांसीसी सैनिक को मिली थी घड़ी- 4 मई 1945 को, जब हिटलर की बटालियन बवेरिया के ऊंचे इलाकों में बेरख्सगाडेन में पीछे हटने लगी, तब एक फ्रांसीसी सैनिक को ये घड़ी युद्ध की लूट के तौर पर मिली थी। नीलामीकर्ता के अनुसार, घड़ी बनाने वालों और सैन्य इतिहासकारों ने घड़ी की पृष्ठभूमि का अध्ययन किया है और इस आम सहमति पर पहुंचे हैं कि एडोल्फ हिटलर वास्तव में इसके मालिक थे।

हिटलर की पत्नी इवा ब्राउन की निक्कर हो चुकी है नीलाम- हिटलर की पत्नी इवा ब्राउन की पिंक निक्कर करीब 3 लाख में नीलाम हुए। इसे यूके के कारोबारी ने खरीदा है। इसके अलावा कारोबारी ने हिटलर की पत्नी का नाइट ड्रेस भी खरीदा है, जिसकी कीमत 2.5 लाख बताई जा रही है। टोसेस्टर में आयोजित 'हम्बर्ट और एलिस ऑक्शन' की उसी नीलामी में, हरमन गोर्गि की पत्नी एमी का एक ब्रेसलेट भी नीलाम किया गया।

पाकिस्तान में हिंदू लड़की बनी DSP और सीनैट उम्मीदवार भी बनी हैं हिंदू बेटियां

आमतौर पर पाकिस्तानी समाज रूढ़ीवादी माना जाता है। जहां महिलाओं के लिए पढ़-लिख कर मुख्यधारा में आना मुश्किल होता है। लेकिन सिंध प्रांत की मनीषा रुपेता ने पुलिस अधिकारी (DSP) बन कर इतिहास रच दिया है। खास बात यह है कि मनीषा पाकिस्तान में अल्पसंख्यक हिंदू समुदाय से ताल्लुक रखती हैं।

सिंध में ही हर साल हजारों हिंदू लड़कियों का अपहरण और जबरन धर्मांतरण होता है। ऐसे में एक हिंदू लड़की का डीएसपी बनना बड़ी बात मानी जा रही है। दुनिया भर की मीडिया ने इस खबर को तक्जो दी है।

मनीषा रुपेता, जो पाकिस्तान की धारणा बदलना चाहती हैं- पाकिस्तान में आम धारणा है कि अच्छे घर की महिलाएं थाने और कोर्ट नहीं जाती हैं। मनीषा पाकिस्तान की इसी सोच को बदलना चाहती हैं। BBC की एक रिपोर्ट के मुताबिक मनीषा ने कहा, 'बचपन से यही बताया गया कि कौन सा पेशा महिलाओं के लिए है और कौन सा नहीं। इसलिए मैं पुलिस में जाकर इस धारणा को बदलना चाहती थी।'

Türkiye targets \$37 billion in tourism revenues this year



Türkiye has revised up-wards its tourism revenue tar-get from a previous \$35 billion to \$37 billion this year. Culture and Tourism Minister Mehmet Nuri Ersoy has said as tourism re-venues soared 190 percent in the second quarter.

The country now eyes wel-coming 47 million foreign tourists in 2022, also revising this target from a previous 42 million tour-ists, he also said.

Some had doubted that the targets set for this year could be met amid the conflict in the Black Sea, the minister said, referring to the war between Ukraine and Russia.

“If there will not be any other global troubles, we will revise upward targets again. If things go as we predict, the number of tourists will surpass the 2019 level,” he said.

2019 marked the best year ever for the tourism sector when 51.7 million holidaymakers visited the country and tourism revenues reached \$34.5 billion.

Ersoy also said Türkiye fared better than its competitors, such as Spain, Italy and Greece, referring to data comparing the first four months of 2019 and 2020.

Türkiye lost fewer tourists in those periods compared to those countries, he added.

Uttarakhand to develop 46 ropeway projects across state

The Uttarakhand government led by chief minister Pushkar Singh Dhami has given a go-ahead to develop 46 ropeway projects under the Parvatmala scheme to boost tourism across the state, tourism minister Satpal Maharaj said in Dehradun.

“The hill state of Uttarakhand understands the importance of ropeway which is considered as the most eco-friendly mode of transport; hence we have decided to develop 46 ropeway projects across the state which will also provide a boost to tourism,” he said during the meeting of the Uttarakhand tourism development board held in Dehradun. The tourism minister directed the officials to explore the possibility of the funicular railway system in places where there is no possibility of setting up a ropeway project. Funicular railway or incline railway is a system that is beneficial for pulling trains up steep grades with a cable where the steel wheels can be used to guide the train along the tracks without traction.

Vietnam’s tourism boom stimulates economic recovery



At the peak of summer, tens of millions of tourists are flocking to various destinations, an increase of many times over the same period in 2020. Tourism revenue has reached hundreds of trillions of VND, promoting the development of many other fields such as transportation, accommodation and food services.

According to the latest report of the Vietnam National Administration of Tourism, in the first six months of 2022, the country served about 60.8 million domestic tourists. In June alone, when the summer vacation

began, the number of tourists was estimated at 12.2 million, a record number since COVID appeared. Vibrant festivals have been held again, passengers are crowded at airports, hotels are “burned out”, and bustling crowds of people at entertainment parks and attractions are blowing life to tourism.

Many destinations in the country have substantial tourist numbers and revenue growth, and Quang Ninh welcomed 5.5 million tourists, 2.2 times higher than last year. Sam So surpassed Ha Long, Nha Trang to become the leading tourist destination in the country in the first six months of the year. The number of tourists was estimated at 4.4 million, 2.59 times higher than in 2021. Sam Son’s attractions this summer include a series of exciting and classy events, festivals and entertainment, organised by the locality with the companionship of Sun Group.

Colombia Tourism Is Poised for Transformation Under New President

Before the global health crisis, Colombia was all the rage as travelers and digital nomads flocked to Bogota, Medellin, and Cartagena, at a record 4.5 million visitors in 2019. Post pan-demic, international tourism has steadily bounced back, reaching 77 percent of 2019 levels in the first quarter of 2022.

There’s a larger promise of transformation looming over Colombia, however — and it’s one that could position its tourism industry on the path to becoming a model of inclusivity, equity and sustainability in the region. On August 7, the country’s first left-wing president, Gustavo Petro, and its first Afro-Colombian vice president, Francia Marquez, will take office. The most diverse government yet to lead Colombia includes the first Afro-Colombian ambassador to the United States — engineer and environmental leader Luis Gilberto Murillo — and social leader Guneywya or Leonor Zalabata Torres, from the Indigenous Arhuaco community, as Colombia’s ambassador to the United Nations.
